About the Mayor's Conservation Corps

YOU can get valuable work experience while making the District cleaner and more beautiful. Jobs in the Mayor's Conservation Corps (MCC) will include street clean-ups, graffiti removal, and school, park and neighborhood-specific projects.







Here's how the program works:

- MCC will run June 18—August 21, 2009.
- MCC is part of the District's Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP). To work for any SYEP program, you need to register.
- We will employ close to 4,000 youth, who will work in teams of 75-150 and take part in enrichment classes.
- We will also hire up to 400 Supervisors and Team Leaders. To apply for these positions, visit green.dc.gov/mcc.
- Supervisors, Team Leaders and Youth will all participate in orientation.
- Youth registering after the May 1st deadline will automatically be assigned to the MCC.

MCC PROJECTS

Youth in the Mayor's Conservation Corps will do the following:

-  Graffiti Abatement
-  Removal of Trash from Parks/Neighborhoods
-  Tree Planting
-  Educational and Personal Enrichment Classes

How To Apply

Youth Participants

If you're between the ages of 14-21 and you live in the District, you're eligible for the Mayor's Conservation Corps. To begin the process:

- Register for the Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) at does.dc.gov.
- After the May 1st deadline, youth will be assigned to the MCC program.

Supervisors /Team Leaders

People interested in becoming an MCC Supervisor or Team Leader can follow these instructions:

- If between the ages of 18-21, you will begin by registering with the SYEP at does.dc.gov.
- To apply for the Supervisor and Team Leader positions, apply online at green.dc.gov/mcc
- Supervisors and Team Leaders must have 1 to 2 years of college and experience working with youth.
